THE PROGRAM

Norman County Soybean/Corn Growers is offering two (2) \$500 college scholarships to assist high school juniors and seniors who are working toward a degree in soybean/corn agronomy, soil science, soybean/corn genetics, food sciences, animal nutrition or large animal veterinary.

This scholarship program is administered by the directors of Norman County from the Minnesota Soybean/Corn Research & Promotion Council and the Minnesota Soybean-Corn Growers Association. Awards are granted without regard to race, color, creed, religion, gender, disability or national origin.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

Applicants to the Minnesota Soybean/Corn Research & Promotion Council College Scholarship must be –

1. A student of a Norman County school or parents that are Norman County producers
2. From a family who is active in agriculture
3. A junior or senior in high school
4. Pursuing an education in soybean agronomy, soil science, soybean genetics, large animal vet or animal nutrition
5. Active in ag-related, campus and/or community activities
