Applicant Qualifications:

- Must be current MCGA Young Adult Member. Become a member. [Join now](#) (it's just \$20).
- Applicants must be enrolled as a full-time student at a post-secondary educational institution during the fall 2019 semester.
- Applicants must be pursuing a career or degree in an agriculture-related field.
- Current MCGA and MCR&PC directors' children, and MCGA employees' children are not eligible.

- Winners will be notified on or before April 1, 2019.
- Scholarship winners must submit a copy of paid college or university registration for the fall 2019 semester to the MCGA office. A check for the scholarship amount will be mailed to the student after registration is verified.
- Awardees may only receive the scholarship once.
