Speaker: Scott Newberg

Scott Newberg grew up on a dairy farm south of Willmar near Blomkest. His family had 138 cows in a free stall barn with a double eight parallel parlor not including young stock. In addition, they farmed 500 acres which included corn, soybeans and alfalfa.

Newberg graduated from the University of Minnesota Morris with a degree in Business Management in 2001. From there he took a break from the farm and managed a few retail companies such as Target, Old Navy and Herberger's, eventually coming back to the farm and buying his own herd in 2007. Newberg managed the farm with his parents until they decided to retire in late fall of 2014.

With his parents stepping away from the farm, and the blessing of twins on the way, Newberg needed to look into a position in which he could continue his love for agriculture but juggle his growing family. With his Business Management degree, Newberg looked into a few different options but stumbled upon the County Executive Director position with FSA and was hired in 2015. After completing the training program, he was appointed as the Director of the Dakota/Scott/Washington/Ramsey office in the Southwestern metro and served there for two years, in Lyon County in Marshall for another two years, and eventually came home to Kandiyohi County in January 2019.

Newberg is honored to serve the producers in Kandiyohi County. Together, with county office staff, they continue to communicate and educate USDA programs to our producers that can best serve them in their operations.
