Exports of grain and grain products added \$5.62 Billion in value to the Minnesota

economy in 2021, according to a ComplEat Analytics study commissioned by the U.S. Grains Council and the National Corn Growers Association.

In an outstanding year for grain and grain product exports, Minnesota grain and grain product exports were valued at \$2.563 Billion. The value of these exports created ripple effects throughout the economy, positively impacting jobs, gross state product and economic output.
