

## Requirements for Wright-Hennepin Corn Growers Scholarship

1. Student must be enrolling to pursue further education in the agricultural industry.
2. Applicant must plan to attend either a 2 or 4 year college.
3. Student's permanent address has to be from one of the two participating counties: Wright or Hennepin.
4. Recipients will be chosen on the basis of scholastic involvement, home and community involvement, and a short essay describing their educational goals.
5. Payment of scholarship will be made to the student upon completion of 1<sup>st</sup> semester of the 1<sup>st</sup> year in the agriculture institution of their choice.
6. Scholarship amount is \$750. Each FFA Chapter of Buffalo-Hanover-Montrose, Howard Lake-Waverly-Winsted, Dassel-Cokato, and Rockford will receive one \$750 scholarship to one of their chapter members.
7. Application deadline. May 1<sup>st</sup> 2024. Send in as soon as possible. That allows us to mention your award at your scholarship announcements for your school.
