**Growers 2024 ADULT Scholarship Program**

1. Individual must be working in a Ag related field wanting to further their agriculture education and or leadership skills.
  - A. Enrollment in a master's or doctoral program
  - B. Enrollment in a ag-based leadership program
2. Scholarship will be awarded on the following criteria:
  - A. Individual must reside in Sibley County or Nicollet County
  - B. Individual must be a Nicollet/Sibley County Corn or Soybean Growers member
  - C. Activities in college or profession
  - D. Community activities
  - E. Scholarship will be awarded based on a 2.0 GPA or higher after 1<sup>st</sup> semester. For leadership program, completion of 1st half of program.
3. Short Essay on each topic (2 – 3 paragraphs)
  - A. Essay based on what the individual has accomplished being involved in agriculture
  - B. Future plans with his/her advanced degree in agriculture or leadership skills
  - C. The future of corn and soybeans. You can talk about markets, uses and technology advances and any research that you may find.
4. Nicollet/Sibley County Corn/Soybean Growers Board members will determine who will receive the two \$500 scholarships
5. Students can become a member of either organization and then become eligible for the scholarship program.
6. Deadline: April 1, 2024
